Proverbs 3:1-12 & 1 Cor. 10:31-34

READ Proverbs 3:1-12

HOW do you make big choices in your life?

| -What is your plan when you will face something big and need to decide between difficult choices? |

| -At times, Scripture is crystal clear on what to do, how to act, which choice to make: - Then, there are <u>Gray</u> areas in life which Scripture does not particularly address. So what do you do???? = You have to lean on Biblical (= what reflects the Character of ?) = What do we know the Bible teaches that applies to area of my life? |
| 1. <u>Consider the</u> (decision) – Are there any revealed scriptures prohibiting it? If so, reject it immediately Obedience = peace (Ps. 116:16; Jn. 17:17; Mt. 4:4; 5:17-18) |
| 2. <u>Consider the</u> : (<i>Every</i> Choice You make will affect your: family, friends, future, fellowship w/ God) -Is my motivation Love? -Could this bring to me? My testimony? Could it harm others? - Could this Cause Addiction? |
| (Romans 15:1-6; 1 Cor. 6:12; 10:23-25) -What is my motivation in this decision? We should include Kindness, Selflessness, Graciousness, Servant-heartedness in our decision-making: |
| 3. <u>Compare</u> your choices to the very of God; in which of the choices will God be most glorified? How will this choice promote blessings to others? How will it help me reflect God more faithfully? |
| 4. Commit your <u>& your choice to God</u> ; trust God to supernaturally open/close "doors" where needed -Can I trust that God is leading me to do this for His glory? (Romans 14:23) |
| 5. <u>Count on God's</u> to lead you, correct you, and sustain you in <u>God's peace</u> (John 14:27) |
| In discerning our next right move, we must be willing to be ruthlessly honest with ourselves. We must <i>suspect</i> ourselves; ask ourselves why we feel a particular course of action will be right, & be willing to yield to God's voice & leading over our voice & desires! (Ps.37:4) |

| Life's Three Ultimate Choices: - Who you love: (God or self) - How you live: (Faith or Fear) - Where you die: (in a state of regret or blessed exhaustion) = legacy, Kingdom, Eternal Investment |
