## The Mission Heart of God

What is your Rescue Story? (Testimony) [Life before/how met Jesus/life since salv.] God is a relational, missional, and Rescuing God. God's heart is to save (rescue) sinners

**God is the God of salvation.** Hebrews 12:2 "God is the Author (originator) and Perfecter of our faith" – God <u>initiates</u> our salvation; He is working behind the scenes to show us that we are sinners in need of a Savior. He enlightens our dark minds; His Spirit shows us that we are lost and in need of a Savior; His Spirit regenerates our hearts; He gives us faith to believe/trust

**-God <u>perfects</u> our salvation.** God finishes what He begins. Phil 1:6 "He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ." John 10:28-29 "I give them eternal life, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. <sup>29</sup> [a] My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of the Father's hand." Eternal Assurance; Eternal Security = Union w/ Christ

God is at work (invisibly; supernaturally) to change hearts and redeem souls – To Rescue us \*\*Last week, Acts 8, God divinely orchestrated Philip to meet with Ethiopian Eunuch -Notice the heart of God for saving sinners, & what God does to bring divine appmts...

READ Acts 10 SCENE: four actors, 2 cities, two big miracles, many lives changed.... Now there was a man in Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort, <sup>2</sup> a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, and made many charitable contributions to the *Jewish* people and prayed to God continually. <sup>3</sup> About the ninth hour of the day [3pm] he clearly saw in a vision an angel of God who had just come in and said to him, "Cornelius!" <sup>4</sup> And he looked at him intently and became terrified, and said, "What is it, lord?" And he said to him, "Your prayers and charitable gifts have ascended as a memorial offering before God. 5 Now dispatch some men to Joppa [33miles away] and send for a man *named* Simon, who is also called Peter; 6 he is staying with a tanner *named* Simon, whose house is by the sea." 7 When the angel who \*spoke to him left, he summoned two of his [c] servants and a devout soldier from his personal attendants, 8 and after he had explained everything to them, he sent them to Joppa. 9 On the next day, as they were on their way and approaching the city, Peter went up on the dhousetop about the sixth hour to pray [noon]. 10 But he became hungry and wanted to eat; but while they were making preparations, he fell into a trance [lit. ecstatic vision] 11 and he \*saw the sky opened up, and an [f] object like a great sheet coming down, lowered by four corners to the ground, 12 and on it were all kinds of four-footed animals and [g] crawling creatures of the earth and birds of the sky. 13 A voice came to him, "Get up, Peter, [h]kill and eat!" 14 But Peter said, "By no means, Lord, for I have never eaten anything []unholy and unclean." 15 Again a voice came to him a second time, "What God has cleansed, no longer [i] consider unholy." 16 This happened three times, and immediately the [k] object was taken up into the sky. <sup>17</sup> Now while Peter was greatly perplexed in [I]mind as to what the vision which he had seen might [m] mean, behold, the men who had been sent by Cornelius had asked directions to Simon's house, and they appeared at the gate; <sup>18</sup> and calling out, they were asking whether Simon, who was also called Peter, was staying there. <sup>19</sup> While Peter was reflecting on the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, [11] three men are looking for you. 20 But get up, go downstairs and accompany them [0] without misgivings, for I have sent them Myself." <sup>21</sup> Peter

went down to the men and said, "Behold, I am the one you are looking for; what is the reason for which you have come?"<sup>22</sup> They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and God-fearing man well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews, was *divinely* directed by a holy angel to send for you *to come* to his house and hear a message from you." <sup>23</sup> So he invited them in and gave them lodging.

Now on the next day he got ready and went away with them, and some of the brothers from Joppa accompanied him. <sup>24</sup> On the following day he entered Caesarea. Now Cornelius was expecting them and had called together his relatives and close friends. <sup>25</sup> When Peter entered, Cornelius met him, and fell at his feet and <sup>[q]</sup>worshiped *him*. <sup>26</sup> But Peter helped him up, saying, "Stand up; I, too, am just a man." <sup>27</sup> As he talked with him, he entered and \*found many people assembled. <sup>28</sup> And he said to them, "You yourselves know that it is forbidden for a Jewish man to associate with or visit a <sup>[r]</sup>foreigner; and *yet* God has shown me that I am not to call any person <sup>[s]</sup>unholy or unclean.

**Vs. 33:** Cornelius=So I sent *men* to you immediately, and you have [4] been kind enough to come. Now then, we are all here present before God to hear everything that you have been commanded by the Lord."

34 Opening his mouth, Peter said: "I most certainly understand *now* that God is not one to show partiality, <sup>35</sup> but in every nation the one who [☑] fears Him and [☑] does what is right is acceptable to Him. <sup>36</sup> The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, preaching [☑] peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—Peter shares the gospel

**Vs. 44:** While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message. <sup>45</sup> All the Jewish believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had also been poured out on the Gentiles. <sup>46</sup> For they were hearing them speaking with tongues and exalting God. Then Peter responded, <sup>47</sup> "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized, who have received the Holy Spirit just as we *did*, can he?" <sup>48</sup> And he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days." **HUGE!!!** 4 actors: (God/Spirit, Angel, Cornelius & Peter)

## In Scripture as a record of Redemptive History...

- -God shows us progressive revelation. Dispensation of <u>Law</u> (OT); dispensation of <u>Grace</u> (NT) = <u>Under the LAW</u>, <u>God showed Israel how to live righteously</u>/Under Grace=<u>He did it for them</u>
  -God called, blessed, provided for His chosen people Jews=(*blessed to be a blessing*) Is. 42:6
  "I will appoint you as a Covenant to the people (gentiles), as a light to the nations" (gentiles)
  Is. 49:6 "I will also make you a light of the nations so that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth." God chose and blessed the Israelites. BUT, God called them to be a <u>witness</u>!!
  -God began a new dispensation (GRACE) after the CROSS, that salvation, spiritual inheritance, & blessing was for Jew <u>& Gentile</u> (Eph. 3) = Jew no longer favored. CHRIST was favored!=<u>Union</u>
  -What was previously bound up in the LAW, is now <u>fulfilled</u> IN Christ through Grace.
- -Peter was the first to learn this lesson in this text. Paul perfected it in Rom./Gal./Eph.
- -NOTICE how God was at work in the Roman Centurion's life.
- **Vs. 2:** a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, and made many charitable contributions to the *Jewish* people and **prayed to God continually**. **Vs. 22** They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and God-fearing man well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews."
- -Cornelius was a "good" guy (took care of family, devout, gave alms, prayed)=but <u>STILL LOST</u>
- -Out of God's kindness, God orchestrated a divine moment for Cornelius & drew Peter to him

- -God sent an Angel to Cornelius in a vision = Divine Revelation, Special Revelation to lost soul
- -God sent a vision to Peter, showing him a new dispensation. OT Law has been fulfilled/Christ
- -In the new dispensation of Grace, nothing (**Ceremonial** within Lev. law) is unclean any longer. (BUT.... **God's Moral law & civil law still stood**). = Jews can associate w/Gentiles -Everyone/anyone is NOW reconciled to God ONLY through a saving faith rel. w/ Jesus Christ!
- **2 Big Miracles**: 1) Change in dispensation for Jewish people toward Gentiles/Law vs. Grace 2)God brought Peter to share gospel with Cornelius/family/friends =all get saved! Life change!
- -Look what God sent Jesus to do for YOU. Jesus came to give His holy and sinless life as THE sacrifice, once for all, for you that if you would embrace this divine moment to run to Him.

## **APPLICATION:**

- -Who do you sense God is drawing you toward, that God would use you to give the hope of Christ away to share the message of the gospel? Are you available, ready for a divine appointment?
- -Who are you still acting like is "untouchable" or "unclean" who you have prejudice against?
- -What in your life do you need the Lord to change your mind on? Stuck in the past? Stuck in a past hurt/wound? Stuck in a wrong attitude or perspective? God wants to change it and show you His heart, His calling, and your obedience = blessing!
